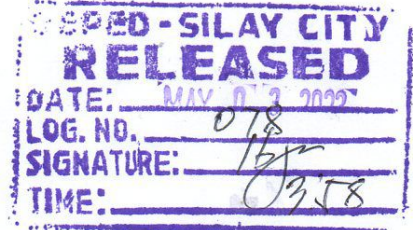



IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MODULAR DISTANCE LEARNING DUE TO EXTREMELY HIGH TEMPERATURE OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND OTHER UNFAVORABLE WEATHER CONDITION

1. As provided in DO 37, s. 2022 or the "Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions, and Other Calamities, and supported by OASOPS No. 2023-077 Memorandum, the field is hereby informed of the **Implementation of the Modular Distance Learning Due to Extremely High Environmental Temperature and Other Unfavorable Weather Condition.**
2. The main school intervention for extremely high temperature is to hold face-to-face classes as early 6:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and resort to modular modality in the afternoon when the heat is expected to be in its highest.
3. Schools may modify the main intervention and adopt the flexible learning options depending on the situation as soundly assessed by the School DRRM Committee.
4. All schools shall submit a weekly monitoring report every Friday to the Office of the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent using the previously issued High Heat Index Reporting Form starting May 12, 2023.
