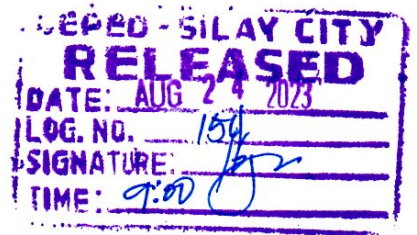

SURVIVAL TRAINING COURSE FOR EAGLE & VENTURER SCOUT ASPIRANTS

1. Attached is the Boy Scouts of the Philippines- Negros Occidental Council Office Memorandum No. 18, s. 2023 titled **Survival Training Course for Eagle and Venture Scout Aspirants** on **August 24-27, 2023** at **SORETA, Patag, Silay City**.
2. The objectives aim to equip Senior Scouts on how to survive in the forest or jungle using an improved shelter and utensils; teach scouts how to look and identify edible and non-edible plants and animals using their power of observations introduced by the founder of Scouting; conduct tree planting activities, clean-up drives in forests, and train them to care for trees and animals, other techniques in protecting our natural resources for future generations.
3. Participants in this activity must be currently registered Senior Scouts (13 years old but not over 17 years old); a holder of Outdoorsman Scout Rank for Venturer Scout Aspirants Survival Training Course and a holder of Venturer Scout Rank for Eagle Scout Aspirants Survival Training Course. Also, the participation of the following Training Team Members to serve as Training Staff:

4. The Schedule medical examination for the aspiring participants will be on **August 24, 2023, 3:00 pm** c/o Medical Officer III, Dr. Vicente P. Gabales, Jr. at the Division Office Health Clinic.
5. A registration fee of **Five Hundred Pesos only (Php 500)** shall be charged against Local Fund/MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and

regulations. Expenses related to the conduct of this activity to defray and cover the transportation, certificates, other administrative expenses, and meals of the members of the Survival Training Course Staff.

6. All participants must **secure students' parental consent & waiver** to be submitted to the Training Team Members.

7. In the conduct of the activity, the participants will adhere to the minimum health and safety protocols to be observed to wit; must be physically fit, observance of bubble system, and physical distancing and fully vaccinated with vaccination ID.

8. All teaching and non-teaching personnel shall be entitled to Service Credit in the duration of the training, in accordance with item No. 4.11 of DO 53, s.2003 - Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers Amended by DO 84, s. 2003 – Addendum to DepEd Order NO. 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers).

It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination in the provision of Learning and Development intervention on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion, or other similar factors/ personal circumstances that run encounter to the principles of equal opportunity.

5. Just bring your own tents for Scouts, Outfit Advisors, Staff and those who are involved in the Activity.


6. **Qualifications for Survival Training Course:**
