In 2012, the state mandated professional competencies and professional qualifications standards through E.O. No. 110, R.A. 10172 or the Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF). In 2016, PQF was institutionalized by R.A. No. 10958 or the Philippine Qualifications Framework Act. Further, in 2016, R.A. No. 10912 or the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Act imposed into law CPD as a requirement in most of the Professional Regulatory Laws of the regulated profession.

Since then, the enhancement of professional competitiveness was spurred down by various serious challenges such as those in the political, economic, socio-cultural, technological, environmental and legal, and specifically entrenched by the pandemic.
