

REGIONAL ART COMPETITION IN CELEBRATION OF THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN EGYPT AND THE PHILIPPINES

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum DM-CT-2023-018 titled Invitation to Join an Art Competition in Celebration of the 75th Anniversary of Diplomatic Relations Between Egypt and the Philippine, this Office, through Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall spearhead the Regional Art Competition in Celebration of the 75th Anniversary of Diplomatic Relations Between Egypt and the Philippines with the theme, "Egypt in the Eyes of the Filipino Children."
- 2. The activity aims to showcase the talents of Filipino learners and uncover their perspectives, through their artwork, and how they reflect on the depth of friendship between the two countries.
- 3. The details on the schedule and mechanics of the said contest are as follows:
 - a. The Regional Arts Competition shall be held on June 20, 2023.
 - b. There shall be one (1) entry from each schools division per category: Category A- Grades 1-3 & Category B- Grades 4-6. (Two learners may collaborate and work together on one (1) category if they belong to the same school and grade level).
 - c. All division entries should be submitted on or before July 15, 2023 and must indicate the following information in their output:
 - c.1. Full name
 - c.2. Grade Level
 - c.3. School
 - c.4. Schools Division
 - d. The champion for each category shall represent DepEd Region VI for the National Competition July 7, 2023.
 - e. All regional winners and coaches will receive a Certificate of Recognition and the Certificate of Participation will be given to non-winners, including the coaches.
 - h. The criteria for judging are as follows:
 - 35% relevance to the theme
 - 30% originality
 - 25% creativity and presentation; and
 - 10% over-all impact
- 4. Activity- related expenses are chargeable against local funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Contest Mechanics:

- 1. Entries should follow the theme, "Egypt in the Eyes of the Filipino Children".
- All entries/paintings shall be on illustration board (15 x 20 inches), using either oil pastel or crayon.
- 3. The contest is open to all public and private elementary students.
- 4. There are two (2) categories:

Category A: Grades 1-3.

Category B: Grades 4-6

** Two (2) students may collaborate and work together on one (1) entry provided that they belong to the same school and grade level.

- 5. Each DepEd Regional Office should submit one (1) entry for each category to the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) on or before July 7, 2023 for final judging.
- 6. Winning entries shall become the property of the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt while non-winning entries shall be the property of the event organizer should it not be claimed in 90 days after awarding ceremonies.
- 7. The winners (per category) will receive a crystal trophy and the following cash prizes:

	Grade 1-3	Grade 4-6
Grand Winner	Php 40,000.00	Php 50,000.00
1st Runner-up	Php 30,000.00	Php 40,000.00
2nd Runner-up	Php 15,000.00	Php 20,000.00
Finalist	Php 1,000.00	Php 1,500.00

- Prizes shall be provided and covered by the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt.
- 9. The schedule of the Awarding Ceremony shall be on July 20, 2023 and the venue shall be announced through an Advisory.
